## A Message from Rabbi Jon Adland

Around the end of March, Temple Israel will join with St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Rivertree Christian Church, and the Islamic Society of Northeast Ohio to build a home for a needy and deserving family through Habitat for Humanity. I know that Temple Israel did this not too long ago, but long enough that I wasn't here yet. It is time to build not just a house, but a home, again. I am thankful that our Temple President Ron Gelb suggested this and I am thankful that leadership has stepped forward to make sure that we have the volunteers needed to do our part. How to sign up and the exact building dates will be available after the middle of January.

Building a Habitat for Humanity home with Christians and Muslims at this particular time is very important for our community. As I've written before and spoken about as often as I can, we need to stop demonizing people based on their religion or race or anything that makes people unique. I am currently reading, "One Summer: America 1927" and in this book it talks about the rise of eugenics, the re-emergence of the KKK, prohibition, the prejudice toward Italians, Jews, anybody not Nordic, the anarchy evident through ongoing bombings, and the crackdown on Communists and other "subversive" groups. The 1920's was a crazy, roller coaster of a ride, prohibition, prejudice, hate, and incredible technical breakthroughs. As I read this book, I can't but help draw comparisons to today. The world is becoming ever more complicated, there is tremendous fear of the other, and yet, at the same time, the technology available to us is just amazing. At the tap of a finger, we have instant information and communication. I am certainly not against this as I type away on my MacBook Air with my iPhone 6 on one side of me and my Kindle on the other, but this instantaneous knowing is also what is provoking fear and angst.

Immediacy is allowing for rumors and innuendo to become real. Facebook and Twitter spread truth and lies within seconds, and who suffers. Those without the power and those who are made to feel afraid. Without question, right now this is the Muslim community in America, but it has been Italians, Mexicans, Africans and Jews. This simple act of building a Habitat for Humanity home which was begun last fall before all the tensions increased will end up being larger than a simple act. We will work side by side with people who have different understandings of the path to God, but know that each path is worth walking for the one who

Lt. Greg Boudreaux of Canton Police Department is the guest speaker for Temple Israel's MLK Shabbat service on January 15 at 7:30 p.m. Lt. Boudreaux will speak on Community Police Relations in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century.

Lt. Boudreaux is currently the Training Bureau Commander for the City of Canton. He was born and raised in Louisiana and moved to Canton in the late 1960's, attended Canton City Schools and graduated from McKinley High School. He joined the Canton Police Department in 1986, becoming one of the city's first DARE officers (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) where he taught hundreds of children the dangers of alcohol and drug abuse. He has received many recognitions and awards, including the Community Initiative Award from Coming Together Stark County for increasing minority hiring in the Canton Police Department and Officer of the Year, 1992. He is married to Tammy and is the father of two.
